I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to address a matter of growing concern regarding the registration process for our qualifying shows. It has come to our attention that some members have been arriving at the shows with incomplete or incorrect registrations. While we are committed to the smooth operation of these events, it is crucial to emphasize that the responsibility of ensuring proper registration falls solely on the members and not show management.

We propose that a more structured approach be implemented to ensure that all participants handle their registrations well before Show Day. This will not only reduce the last-minute pressure on the show chairs but will also promote fairness and professionalism throughout the entire process.

To safeguard the time and efforts of those tasked with managing the shows, we respectfully request that a clear communication be sent out to the exhibitors, reinforcing that all registration issues must be resolved in advance. **Any pending registrations that have not been fully completed with the TLBAA office by show day will result in the animal being ineligible to participate in the event. Additionally, memberships must be up to date and renewed as necessary, as any lapses in membership status will also render animals ineligible to show.**

If a member arrives at a show without proper registration or an active membership, they should not expect show management to fix these problems. **It is important to stress that only the member or the owner of the animal may update or correct registrations and memberships. This is a responsibility that lies with the members themselves, and they must be held accountable for their own entries and membership status.**

We believe this measure will significantly reduce unnecessary complications and help ensure a more efficient and enjoyable experience for all involved.

Thank you for your attention to this matter. We look forward to your support in encouraging all members to take responsibility for their registrations and membership renewals prior to show day.
